

Practice Philosophy

The philosophy of this veterinary hospital is to offer the best preventative health care for all patients. I believe in educating the client about why I advise certain preventative health care - teeth cleaning, heartworm preventative, yearly exams with annual vaccinations - and allow the client to make the final decisions about their pet's care. When a pet is sick, again I believe in giving the client all the treatment options from conservative to aggressive and inform them so they can make an educated decision about how their pet will be treated.



Boarding

I have 9 indoor dog runs and 8 "kitty condos", to house your pets on my property where I live. The kennel building is just about 50 feet from my house, has big picture windows and a sliding glass door looking out to the wonderful view of the Angel Fire ski mountain. We walk the dogs individually all around our 14.5 acres twice a day. Rates are \$18.00 per day for dogs and \$15.00 per day for cats. If you board a 2nd pet it will be at a discounted rate. Extra mid-day playtimes are available for \$4.00 each.

Emergency Calls

I will gladly see any emergency or urgent visits. Please call me at home (575-377-5968) or leave a message on my answering machine and I will return your call as soon as possible. Please be sure to leave a message on the machine since I am often just helping in the kennel or on a short errand.



Surgery

Routinely, spays, neuters, teeth cleanings and other surgical procedures will be done late morning so your pet can go home later that same day. Feline declaws will be kept overnight to confine them and decrease chances of postoperative bleeding. Elective surgery and teeth cleanings are usually scheduled for Tuesdays, Wednesdays, or Fridays.
