

# Instructions For Before Your Pet's Procedure please follow this list of guidelines.....

- No food after 9 p.m. the night before your pet's procedure and no food the morning of your pet's procedure; they can have water, even the morning of the procedure.
- Bring your pet to the clinic between 8:30 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. the day the procedure is scheduled.
- Allow yourself 5 - 10 minutes to check your pet in. Feel free to ask any questions during the check-in process.
- Your pet should be ready to go home mid-to-late afternoon the same day of their procedure (\*except for feline de-claws; they spend the night and go home the next morning).
- **Pre-anesthetic Bloodwork** - To ensure your pet can properly process and eliminate an anesthetic, we highly recommend performing bloodwork on all pets undergoing anesthesia. The type of bloodwork varies with the age of your pet.
  - Juvenile Profile (under 4 years of age): \$25.00
  - Adult Profile (dogs 4 - 10yrs, cats 4 - 14yrs): \$45.00
  - Geriatric Profile (dogs 10+ or 8+ if over 80lbs, cats 14+): \$80.00
- **Geriatric patients** - Geriatric dogs (10+ or 8+ for dogs over 80lbs) and cats (14+) will have an intravenous catheter placed to allow immediate access to a vein in case of an emergency or to give fluids during their procedure. It is necessary to clip hair on one of more front legs for this procedure.
- **All patients will receive pain medication when needed.**
